**WEIGHT LIMITS**

**10.06.010**      **Established—Exemption—Local traffic.**

A. It is unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate a motor vehicle or a combination or motor vehicles having a maximum gross licensed weight in excess of fifty-two thousand pounds (52,000 lbs.) through the following roads in unincorporated Franklin County, Washington:

1. Fir Road (09800), from milepost 0.00 at Eltopia West Road to milepost 4.55 at Glade North Road;
2. Farrell Road (09880), in its entirety, from milepost 0.00 at Fir Road to milepost 1.74 at Fir Road;
3. Ione Road (09450), in its entirety, from milepost 0.00 at Sagemoor Road to milepost 2.01 at East Dogwood Road;
4. Cedar Road (09480), from milepost 0.00 at Ione Road to milepost 2.02 at Glade North Road;
5. Dogwood Road (09410), from milepost 0.00 at Ione Road to milepost 1.99 at Glade North Road;
6. Nunamaker Road (01850), in its entirety, from milepost 0.00 at SR 261 to milepost 4.58 at SR 260;
7. Rangeview Road (04960), in its entirety, from milepost 0.00 at Sagehill Road to milepost 4.31 at the end of the road;
8. Mound Road (04990), in its entirety, from milepost 0.00 at Rangeview Road to milepost 0.48 at SR 24;
9. Court Street (11000), from milepost 8.00 at the city limit line to milepost 8.26 at the city limit line.

B. This restriction shall not apply to vehicles that are defined as local traffic. "Local Traffic" is defined as those vehicles required to make deliveries, pick up loads or returning to place of residence at any point on or along the roads. (Ord. 9-2003 (part), 2003)

**10.06.020**      **Documentation required.**

Any person, firm or corporation operating a motor vehicle or combination of motor vehicles on the roads designated in this chapter shall be able to produce a manifest or other document showing the gross weight of the vehicle and load being transported. (Ord. 9-2003 (part), 2003)

**10.06.030 Signage—Authority.**

The director of public works for the county is authorized and directed to erect any signs necessary for advising the public of this chapter and the restriction. (Ord. 9-2003 (part), 2003)

**10.06.040 Violation—Penalty.**

Any person violating this chapter or any section thereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Each time a vehicle is used contrary to this chapter, such occasion shall constitute a separate offense. (Ord. 9-2003 (part), 2003)
